Indicate which of the following categories apply to you:

- Significant disruption to your school (e.g. buildings destroyed)
- Rural schooling (more than 100 km from a town of 10,000 people)
- Frequent change of teachers
- Lack of subject choice

Steps Required

1. Indicate which of the following documents you have supplied in support of your application:

- Disruption to the school Letter from the school or Education Queensland confirming disruption to the school and describing the direct effect on the student.
- Rural School Letter from the school confirming distance from nearest town of 10,000 people and describing the direct effect on the student.
- Change of teachers/lack of subject choice Letter from the school confirming frequent change of teachers or lack of subject choice and the direct effect on the student.

Additionally it will strongly support your application if you provide academic results (e.g. school reports, academic transcripts) that demonstrate a decrease in achievement as a result of your circumstances

2. Personal Statement

You must provide a statement briefly describing the way in which your education has been adversely affected by your school environment. You must provide a separate personal statement for each EAS category for which you apply.

3. Educational Support Statement

You must ensure that your education provider completes an *Educational Support Statement*. Please note that only one statement is required regardless of how many categories you nominate.
