

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) DIPLOMAS COMPLETED IN 2010

Across Australia, a common national measure of Year 12 student achievement called the Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) is used in the tertiary selection process. ATARs are expressed in a scale extending from 99.95 (highest) down to 30.00.

The score out of 45 from the completed IB Diploma is also expressed in this common national measure. Termed the 'Combined Rank', the following table shows the common national measures assigned to each of the IB scores attainable in a completed 2010 IB Diploma:
