The ranks shown in these schedules are based on the best 20 semester units of Authority subjects, Authority-registered subjects and/or Vocational Education and Training (VET) modules recorded on their Senior Statement. For students with twenty or more semester units in Authority subjects, Authority-registered subjects and VET modules, results in the best twenty semester units only, are taken into account.

OP-ineligible students with less than 20 semester units of study will have ranks calculated pro-rata from these schedules based on a proportion of their studies in Authority subjects, Authority-registered subjects and/or VET modules recorded on their Senior Statement. For example, a student with a grade average of 4.00 from 16 semester units of study would be assessed on these new schedules with a grade average of 3.2 (based on 16/20ths of 4.00).

The duration of VET modules is based on total point value of the modules at that level multiplied by 10 in order to be comparable to 55 instructional hours comprising 1 semester unit of Authority and Authority-registered subjects.
