QTAC to release 12,844 early offers before major offer round

Following the release of OPs on Saturday, Queensland Tertiary Admissions Centre (QTAC) expects OP students to start receiving early offers from 21 December.

For the first time, QTAC will make approximately 12,844 early offers to Year 12 students before the January major offer round.

"QTAC's new daily offers model means we are offering to Year 12s earlier than ever before." QTAC CEO Dr John Griffiths said. "This is an exciting opportunity for school leavers as they don't have to wait as long to find out what their future holds."

"In an increasingly demand driven society, students want to know now what their options are so they can plan ahead, and we're offering them that."

Dr Griffiths stresses that Year 12s who don't receive offers tomorrow don't need to worry just yet, as more offers will be made on 16 January, including most high demand courses such as Medicine and Dentistry.

The Queensland Tertiary Admissions Centre (QTAC) operates a centralised tertiary application services for Queensland universities, Australian Maritime College, Bond University medicine, and for some courses at TAFE Queensland, Southern Cross University, University of New England and some private tertiary education providers. QTAC assesses applications using these entry requirements and then makes offers to successful applicants during our offer rounds.
