CHRISTMAS COMES EARLY FOR 10 641 QUEENSLAND YEAR 12 STUDENTS

At 10am on Monday 23 December, 10 641 Queensland Year 12 students will receive a tertiary education offer from QTAC (Queensland Tertiary Admissions Centre.)

In this round, the most offers will be going out to those students who have chosen to do courses in Business, Engineering and Humanities.

QTAC CEO, Dr John Griffiths said "QTAC is in the business of connecting people with opportunities and we are delighted to bring some early Christmas cheer to young Queenslanders who have worked so hard during their final years of high school.

"For those that don't receive an offer on Monday, don't panic, another big offer round takes place on January 15. This round includes the more highly competitive courses of medicine, physiotherapy and veterinary science" said Dr Griffiths

Approximately 16 000 offers will be made over the next month to the last cohort of students using their OP. From 2020 Queensland will fall into line with the rest of Australia by issuing an ATAR (Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank) to Year 12 students.
