## 16 115 QUEENSLAND YEAR 12 STUDENTS HEAD INTO THE HOLIDAY SEASON WITH AN OFFER FROM QTAC

On Thursday 23 December, 11 485 Queensland Year 12 students received a tertiary education offer into over 1000 courses from QTAC (Queensland Tertiary Admissions Centre). Adding this to the 4630 early offers made to students before they'd finished school means 16 115 students are already set for 2022. This represents a 10% increase on last year.

QTAC CEO, Dr John Griffiths said "It's pleasing to see so many Year 12 students receiving an offer prior to Christmas"

"This allows them to head into the holiday season with certainty as to what they will be studying in 2022"

Dr Griffiths added "These students have shown great resilience over the last 2 years which provides a great foundation for their future studies"

In this round the most offered course was Engineering at The University of Queensland. Again, this year, the most popular courses offered were in the field of Society and Culture (see below).
